1.4 TODAY’S THEME COMES FROM:

JOEL 1:14 “Consecrate a fast, Call a sacred assembly; Gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land Into the house of the LORD your God, And cry out to the LORD.”

and

JOEL 2:1 “Blow the trumpet in Zion. Sound the alarm on my Holy Hill...”

1.5 SECOND BLOWING OF THE SHOFAR (Sounding “the Alarm”).

1.6 This prayer summit is at a time when the future of America and our way of life hangs in the balance. Tomorrow we hope we will all join millions of Americans in praying for an hour inside the foyer of our new courthouse from Noon to 1:00 p.m. Everyone is invited. First, we as representative leaders are gathering today in solemn or sacred assembly to cry out to God for a Great Awakening to be caused by a great outpouring of His Holy Spirit to draw all of us and all His people to seek His face and turn from our wicked

ways so that He will hear our prayers, forgive our sin, and heal our land. Let's pray by singing this prayer together:

2.1 Individually we have already begun to "seek God's face".

Next we would like to pray corporately in agreement. Before we engage in prayers led by individuals, we would first like to renew the corporate prayer covenant adopted at prior prayer summits. Over 140 different leaders have participated in praying it over the course of fifteen (15) quarterly prayer summits. We hope you will do so in your own prayer groups. First, let's do it again now.

2.2 In order to think about it and then pray it, please listen as **Chris**

Jones, our Thomas County Fire Chief, reads each section, then **pray responsively in unison**, the following Prayer Covenant:

Our Father, we come to you in the mighty and holy name of Jesus Christ, our Lord.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We affirm our faith in You, Almighty God, and in the foregoing promises from Your Word.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We further affirm our unity in Christ and in our common faith, as expressed in Your Word.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We acknowledge and declare that Jesus Christ is Lord of the Thomasville area, our community, and all the earth.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We thank You, God, for calling us to devote ourselves to the Lord Jesus Christ in brokenness, repentance, and obedience.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We come out of a deep sense of desperation over the lukewarm condition in the church and the acceleration of corruption in our society.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We bow before You, to rend our hearts and not our garments.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We repent of religious pride, of hypocrisy, of prejudice, of status-quo mediocrity, of busyness and prayerlessness.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We repent of materialism, selfish pursuit, and lusts of all varieties.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We acknowledge that the only hope for the Thomasville area and for our nation and world is a mighty reviving work of Your grace.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We beg You, Father, to touch us and draw us to touch You in faith, so that revival will come as we touch your heart and prevail in believing prayer.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We agree in prayer that our community and all the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the Glory of the Lord as the waters cover the seas.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We have full hope and confidence that, as we pray and act in Jesus name, the Kingdom

of our Lord Jesus Christ will be greatly advanced in the Thomasville area and throughout the earth. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done.

------(GROUP REPEAT)-----

We covenant to continue to seek you earnestly and to pray faithfully together for a Biblical spiritual awakening in our personal lives and in the church, and for laborers to advance Christ's Kingdom in our community, our nation, and our world.

We make this petition in Jesus' name and for Jesus' sake, for He is worthy of a Bride without spot or wrinkle, and He is the King over all of His creation. Amen.

9:25 AM 3. Large Group Prayers of Repentance and Intercession:

If we really want God to bless America, we all know we need to repent of our sins. In a moment, we will have a season for us to lead out in group prayers of repentance and intercession, as Daniel did, "identifying" with the sins of Israel when praying for it to be relieved of its captivity by Babylon. We are captive to the Babylon system of this world and its worldly ways that oppose God's ways. As a nation, we have mortgaged our future, owing "trillions" of dollars.

3.1 Repentance from Trusting Men, Not God:

Psalm 118:8 says, **“It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to**

trust in man”. Our national motto is “In God We Trust”. Do we? As we prepare to repent and intercede, let’s each ask God to reveal to us what “fallow” ground he would like us to “plow up” today as we prayerfully consider the following scripture. Please listen and read along as **Rev. Mike Keown, our State Representative**, reads *Hosea 10:12-13*, then leads us in a prayer of repentance.

9:30 AM 3.2 Failure to Build God’s House: Money in Bags with Holes

Our failure to come together in unity to build the “House of the Lord” while we each concentrate on ourselves, may be the reason we now find ourselves putting our money into bags with holes.

Let us consider the application of Haggai 1:6-9 on our community,

nation and world as **Dr. Dan Mitchell, an Elder of Christ Community Church**, reads us the scripture and then leads us in a prayer of repentance.

Haggai 1:6-9 (NKJ): *“You have sown much, and bring in little; You eat, but do not have enough; You drink, but you are not filled with drink; You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm; And he who earns wages, earns wages to put into a bag with holes.” Thus says the LORD of hosts: “Consider your ways! Go up to the mountains and bring wood and build the temple, that I may take pleasure in it and be glorified,” says the LORD. “You looked for much, but indeed it came to little; and when you brought it home, I blew it away. Why?” says the LORD of hosts. “Because of My house that is in ruins, while every one of you runs to his own house.”*

9:35 AM 3.3 Prayers of Repentance: As God pricks your heart and leads you, please take turns leading out in sentence prayers of repentance for some of the different ways in which we have individually or corporately been guilty of building and running to our own houses without participating in or making a priority of building God’s house. Let’s pray for the needs of our community, state, and nation together. Please lead out in short topical sentence prayers. Please be sensitive and wait up to thirty (30) seconds for others to join in adding prayers on the same topic, before changing topics. We will pray for a while, allowing plenty of time for all topics. E.g.,

“Lord, please forgive me for....”

“Lord, please forgive us and our community for

“Lord, please heal our land and ...”

“Lord, please pour out your spirit on us so that”

10:00 AM 4. SEVEN MOUNTAINS: At a prior summit, we talked about the Seven (7) Mountains of Influence in Culture identified by Bill Bright, Francis Schaeffer and others. We invite, as God leads, seven (7) of you to lead us, so that someone prays a specific prayer for each one of the seven areas of influence. Someone who has a special connection to or burden for that sphere of influence, please pray for God to bless and/or raise up Christian leaders and pour out His Spirit to create a “Great Awakening” in each of the following seven (7) areas :

- 4.1 business and professions;
- 4.2 government, military, and law enforcement;
- 4.3 the media;
- 4.4 arts and entertainment;
- 4.5 education;
- 4.6 family and families; and
- 4.7 the church, ministries, and all who call ourselves Christians.

join

Pam Kelly, Retired from Thomas County Schools, as she leads us first in reading the scripture, then in praying for God’s fulfillment of it in our generation.

And deep darkness the people;**

**But the LORD will arise over you,
And His glory will be seen upon you.
The Gentiles shall come to your light,

TARGETED PRAYERS PROCEDURE

PROCEDURE: Most of you have already been to at least one summit. Some of you have been to all fifteen (15) quarterly leadership summits. Already, over 130 leaders have attended at least one (1) of our prior prayer summits. However, for a few, this is your first time. For all of our benefit, **we will outline our group prayer procedure.**

1. We want to pray short, topical prayers to allow others time to hear, understand and agree.
1. Our purpose is to hear one another's hearts and agree.
2. When a person leads out in a topic of prayer, we have agreed to try to keep it short and pointed to one topic only. Then stop. (No "run on" prayers.) We will wait and allow others to join in prayer on the same topic as they are led. This allows us to "agree" with each other's prayers before we switch topics. Because we are here all morning, we have time to be patient.
3. Silence is o.k. We need to listen in silence and then pray as God leads. If the Spirit of God is not leading one of us to pray aloud, we will all enjoy silently listening for Him to speak to each of us.
4. If the facilitator mentions that we appear to be finished with one topic and ready to move on to the next, or if, after 30 seconds or more of silence no one has added to a topic, feel free to lead out in another area, and we will repeat the process.

5. There is no limit to the number of times each person may each pray briefly as different topics arise. Nor is there any stigma to those who choose to agree silently with others and never pray aloud.
6. However, rather than “talk about” needs “to” each other,
we will “talk to God” about needs “in the presence of each other”.

PRAYER PARTNERS

Prayer Partners: As we pray in unity, with even one other person, our power is multiplied. Jesus himself promised:

“...if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.” Matthew 18:19 (NKJ)

Each of us should have one (1) or two (2) personal prayer partners for that reason. If you do not have one, maybe out of these prayer summits you will find one or be inspired to find one.

House of Prayer: Jesus called God’s house a “house of prayer” (Matthew 21:13). We are the living stones in that house. As we join in prayer, we build God’s house.

Corporate Unity Prayer: House of the Lord When we come into the corporate unity for which Jesus prayed, then the world will believe that Jesus is the Messiah and the Son of God who sent Him. We know this because Jesus prayed for us:

“...that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.” John 17:21 (NKJ)
